## 2. HANG A PENDANT BESIDE YOUR BED

**THINK OF YOUR LAMP AS SCULPTURE**

Don't pick a style that fades safely into your room. Let your fixture be a focal point, says Viñas, the N.Y.C. modernist designer who did this guest bedroom for a single, young hedge-fund manager. By picking imaginative forms and setting them against a contrasting wall—in this case, fuchsia—"you can create even more drama," says Viñas.

**POSITION IT PROPERLY** Make sure the diameter of the lamp is smaller than your nightstand. Center it with the fixture roughly 18 inches from the top of the table.

**PUT THE SWITCH WITHIN ARM'S REACH**
